BYLAWS and REGULATION

Article 1

Award

The *Carlotta Award* is aimed to commemorate Carlotta Strampelli-Parisani, wife and inspiring collaborator of Nazzareno Strampelli, in order to celebrate women scientists working on wheat, related species and sustainable food production in the frame of the International Congress "From Seed to Pasta IV".

Article 2

Purpose

The Award will be assigned to a woman scientist, for the most original scientific work carried out in public or private Institutions, working on:

- a) wheat genetics, genomics and breeding (*main thematic areas 1-5);
- b) sustainable wheat production for food security, food quality and safety, durum wheat-pasta value chain (*main thematic areas 6-8).

The prize is awarded to the person and not to the Institution.

Article 3

Candidates

Candidates for the Award must be living individuals, women, under 40 at the deadline submission (15th June 2022).

Candidates for the Award cannot be relatives of the members of the Jury or of the Organizing Committee. Members of the Jury cannot submit applications.

Article 4

Jury

The winner will be selected by a special international Jury of experts and, in case of the same judgment between two (or more) candidates, the youngest will be entitled to the Award as an incentive to her scientific and professional growth.

Article 5

The prize

Carlotta Award 2022 gives a prize money offered by the sponsors as a positive action to women scientists involved in research on (a) genetics and genomics of wheat and related species and, (b) sustainable food production, healthy food and pasta value-chain.

Article 6

Submission of applications

Applications should consist in:

- i. the **copy of abstract** submitted to the Congress 2022 FSTP-4 with the description of an original scientific work. If the abstract represents the result of an experimental work carried out by several co-authors, the candidate must be the *first author*. (Use the abstract guidelines of FSTP-4 and indicate the session of interest, look at: https://www.fromseedtopasta.com).
- ii. a curriculum vitae in European format;
- iii. a submission-form Carlotta AWARD 2022 signed;
- iv. an optional reference letter by a member of the scientific community could also be submitted. It will be appreciated by the Jury but it doesn't give any score.

PLEASE NOTE: all candidates can pay the registration to the congress after the selection by the Jury at the cost of the early fee.

Applications must be submitted personally by the candidates.

After communication by the Jury, the winner should ensure to be in Bologna at the conference FROM SEED TO PASTA-4 to receive the prize and give a talk.

All documentation concerning the candidates becomes an integral part of the acts under the responsibility of the Jury.

Article 7

Evaluation of candidatures

Considering the applications, the Jury will take into account:

- i. novelty and originality of the submitted work;
- ii. intrinsic merit and potential impact of the candidate's achievements;

iii. relevance of the publications;

Article 8

Attribution of the Award

The Jury will assign **two Carlotta Award 2022** definitively and irrevocably **on two main topics:**

- a) genetics, genomics and breeding;
- b) sustainable wheat production for food security, food quality and safety, durum wheat-pasta value chain.

Furthermore, there **will be nominated 4 candidates by** *special mentions* due to their scientific work, on aforesaid main topics, judged excellent independently from high IF publications and/or important funding support.

These special mentions want to award the quality and novelty of the research realized and carried out by women scientists working in developing and/or emerging Countries. The candidates selected by the special mention, will receive, as special gift, the reimbursement for travel, hotel and registration fee costs to attend the FSTP-4 Congress.

The reasons for attributing the Award will be given by the Jury. Members of the Jury act on their behalf and not as representatives of organizations or groups.

The Award must be collected personally during the official Award ceremony.

After communication by the Jury, the winners should ensure to be in Bologna at the conference "From Seed to Pasta IV" to receive the prize/special mention and give a talk.

The ceremony for handing out the 2022 Carlotta Award will take place in the frame of the From Seed To Pasta-4 International Conference, to be held in Bologna 26-28 October 2022, according to the terms and modalities which will be communicated in due time.

Article 9

Liabilities

Upon submission of the application, the participant declares to be solely liable for the violation, if any, of copyrights. The candidate, in conformity with Italian Legislative Decree: d. lgs. n.196/2003, authorizes the organizers to start, also in collaboration with other subjects, activities for the publication, as well as the divulgation and communication to third parties of all the information contained in the works nominated for the Award, as well as the promotion of activities for enterprises, the public administration, schools and universities for enriching the content of the works, citing its origin.

The Organizing Committee shall not be liable for any illegal use of the submitted works.
